Saturday 13 September 2008

Time

7pm–12 midnight (Debutantes and their partners will be required to arrive between 4 and 4.30pm).

Dress Code

Girls' dresses must be full length, white in colour and accompanied by white gloves to the elbow and white shoes (enclosed toes preferred). Strapless gowns are not recommended but if you do choose to have one please ensure it is a firm fit. Boys wear suits, shoes and gloves, all of which are supplied by a formal hire company. Any boy with long hair will be expected to have it tied back off his face. No facial jewellery is to be worn by either boys or girls and no more than one earring in each ear.

A Guide To Costs

We have packaged this together for simplicity and convenience and the package cost is \$450 per couple, which covers the following items:

Dancing lessons for the Debutante and Partner

On top of this you will have the cost of the Debutante's outfit, your choice of photographs and the cost of dinner for family and guests (approximately \$80.00 per head all inclusive).

Dresses may be purchased, hired, borrowed or made.

Petticoats may be hired, borrowed or are very simple to make.

Cost is dependent on your choice.

Gloves Approximately \$20-\$30.

Shoes Dependent on your choice.
