**General Information about the
Program**

1. Speech and Drama is a co-curricular program available to students during term time and is time tabled during the school day. The school employs specialist staff according to the numbers of participating students.
2. The year level at which co-curricular lessons can be commenced varies according to the activity. Parents are asked to give careful consideration to the number of co-curricular activities taken by their child.
3. A Junior School student who wishes to enrol in one or more co-curricular lessons does so at the discretion of the Head of the Junior School who will approve each case according to individual needs.
4. A course of lessons may be commenced during the year at the beginning of a term depending upon the availability of a teacher and timetabling. Application should be made before the end of the previous term.
5. **No allowance can be made for lessons missed through the student's absence or default.** However, if notice of an absence is given in advance of the lesson, every effort will be made to make up the missed time. Teachers are under no obligation to make up lessons missed due to family holidays, illness or forgetfulness.
6. Once co-curricular Speech and Drama lessons are organised it is **expected that the commitment be made for the whole year.** If a student wishes to discontinue lessons, it should be understood that parents must discuss the situation with the relevant teacher. If lessons are to be discontinued, **one term's notice in writing must be supplied** or a term's fees, in lieu of notice, will be required to be paid. Co-curricular fees are included on the school fee account.

SPEECH AND DRAMA

Have you considered enrolling your son or daughter in Speech and Drama. It is taught as an extra curricular subject for years 5–12.

The Speech and Drama program is designed to help students develop skills in giving prepared and impromptu talks and gain confidence in discussion and everyday speech situations.

There is a focus on effective and fluent reading and memorisation of passages from prose, poetry and drama. Movement and mime aims to develop imagination, use of gesture, poise, relaxation, facial expression and necessary skills for characterisation – many of the skills required by actors and performers.

The program encourages clear speech, covers the technique of voice production and the development of effective speech habits.

Students develop skills in prepared and impromptu talks and confidence in discussion and everyday speech situations. There is a focus on effective and fluent reading and memorisation of passages from prose, poetry and drama.

Students enjoy the sense of theatre and have a lot of fun.

AIMS OF THE SPEECH AND DRAMA PROGRAM

The aim of Speech and Drama is to produce confident and articulate young people with highly developed interpersonal and presentation skills.

Specific objectives include the development and enhancement of clear pleasant speech and varied range of vocal tone, self esteem, confidence, imagination and creativity.

Students work in small groups although individual classes are offered to students at the higher level and programs are devised based on their interests and specific vocal needs.

Classes are designed to be stimulating, fun and enjoyable and with some guidance, choice of materials is left largely to students in order to reflect their interests.

Students in Years 5–12 are encouraged to take AMEB (Australian Music Examination Board) examinations in 'Drama and Performance', 'Voice and Communication' or 'Drama and Communication'. These provide accreditation for the student and act as a focus for the year's work.

FEES FOR SPEECH AND DRAMA LESSONS

Students receive 15 lessons per Semester, giving a total of 30 lessons for the year.
