

Considering our genuinely open-entry policy, it is pleasing to see that 54% of our students received an ATAR of 80 or more (2016 – 53%), placing them in the top 20% of Australian final year students. The class of 2017 were a hardworking and committed group of scholars and their achievements reflect their work ethic and application demonstrated consistently throughout the year.

However, success can be measured in many ways and these results, although well-deserved and very impressive, are just one aspect of what we see as an excellent education at Tintern.
