

# TINTERN GRAMMAR ENRICHMENT PROGRAM



The Enrichment program is offered to those students who would benefit from additional intellectual, creative or artistic enrichment.

Identified students in Years 6 and 7 will be able to select one of three enrichment/extension units which will be offered in Term 2. There will be a further three units offered again in Term 3. Each unit will run for 5-6 lessons over the term, at a time nominated by the teacher.

The units are broad and rich in content. Information covered will be intellectually suitable for our brightest students who will benefit from this additional, rigorous material.

## Examples of units which have been offered previously include:

### Mathemagic

Learn tricks for difficult maths calculations - without a calculator - that will have your friends and family amazed.

For example learning to solve “What is the cube root of 175616?” in less than 10 seconds.

### Create a POD

Podcasts are the fastest growing way for everyday people to share their ideas, stories and research. Through participation in ‘create a pod’ students learned the steps to creating an engaging podcast.

### Are They Related?

Students used mathematics to determine if there is a connection between two different variables, then develop an equation to make predictions for future values.

### Big Ideas

Students used high-order thinking to formulate provocative, ambiguous and thought-provoking discussion, with the outcome being determined by students.

### Philosophy: Design the Perfect Society

Students explored some big questions then used new-found knowledge to construct a blueprint for our perception of a more perfect society.

### Sustainable Fashion

Discover where your clothes come from, which brands care about sustainability and which fabrics are more environmentally friendly. In this Unit students gain information and practical skills such as upcycling old clothes, dyeing fabrics and basic leathercraft.
